Solution

Drawing up & Measuring out medication in syringe with needle:

Measure out medication from larger syringe into a treatment syringe

Treatment is 0.2cc for each eye





For Ointments:

Remove the
plunger from the
syringe.



Put the ointment
into the bottom of
the syringe.



Treatment is 0.2 cc

This is about one
fingers width.



Re-insert the
plunger and you
are ready to
treat!

Normal horse eye





This is what a third eyelid looks like.

DO NOT do this!

This is how to insert the medication in the eye without holding lids open.

Remember “I nose which way to point,” towards the nose...this way you will not scratch the eyeball
